Community Events

Car Seat Safety

In 2025, CCHD expanded our outreach to promote Car Seat Safety. This year in addition to our annual Car Seat Saturday Event we also provided free car seat inspections at Pre-K screenings, Now Shopping Day Resource Fair, Little Learners Daycare in Robinson, and Kids Kingdom Daycare in both Oblong and Robinson.

Kidney Mobile - September 22, 2025

National Kidney Foundation's Kidney Mobile provides free health screenings including, blood pressure, blood glucose-HbA1c for diabetics, urinalysis, and blood draw if needed; individuals receive their results the same day. A total of 40 people were screened; 47.5% had at least one abnormal test result, 12.5% were referred for immediate care.



WIC Breastfeeding Award of Excellence



CCHD's WIC Breastfeeding Peer Counseling program was awarded with the Premier Award of Excellence for providing exemplary breastfeeding support services. CCHD was the only agency in the state of Illinois to receive this prestigious award.

CPR Classes

CCHD continues to provide CPR classes to the public. In 2025 we held 8 CPR classes and certified or re-certified a total of 43 individuals.



Mother & Infant Safety Expo - November 18, 2025

CCHD and community partners hosted our 6th Mother & Infant Safety Expo. A total of 33 expectant Mothers attended, visiting 20 informational booths. This year we welcomed the addition of the Fire Extinguisher Simulator loaned to us by Marathon. We also received a \$500 donation from Marathon to help fund this year's event.

Lab Services

CCHD offers laboratory services at significantly reduced costs for uninsured and/or underinsured county residents.

Lead Testing and Case Management

CCHD provides lead screenings and case management for children showing high lead levels.

Better Birth Outcomes—Comprehensive Program (BBO-C)

BBO-C focuses on serving pregnant individuals and their infants through comprehensive one-on-one nursing assessments and personalized support including, care planning, evidence-based health assessments, screenings, medical coordination and more.

Emergency Planning and Preparedness

Emergency Planning and Preparedness is a vital area of public health, especially in Crawford County. This area assists with the health needs of Crawford County citizens during a natural or manmade emergency through planning, exercising, and evaluation. The Department is currently in the process of rebuilding the Crawford County Medical Reserve Corps (MRC). This team would be responsible for recruiting and training volunteers to help meet the needs of our community should an emergency occur. ILLINOIS PROJECT FOR LOCAL ASSESSMENT OF NEEDS (IPLAN)

The Illinois Project for Local Assessment of Needs (IPLAN) is a guide to improving the health of county residents. The plan involves assessment of health needs and collaboration among community partners to address those needs. In order for the Department to maintain its certification with the Illinois Department of Public Health, the IPLAN process must be completed every five years. The IPLAN process was completed and submitted to Illinois Department of Public Health in 2022. The Department is currently certified through July 27, 2027.

The following were identified as the most significant health problems in Crawford County in 2022:

- ◆ Mental/Behavioral Health
- ◆ Obesity/Lifestyle Choices
- ◆ Cancer

IPLAN ACTIVITIES FOR 2024-2025:

- ◆ CCHD continues to increase awareness and improve access to Mental/Behavior Health services by contracting providers from Lawrence County Health Department and Paras Harshawat M.D. to provide these services for Crawford County residents.
- ◆ CCHD has continued to promote tobacco education programs in the schools and recruit additional Illinois Quitline referral partners. In FY25, staff was able to provide the CATCH My Breath program, an evidence-based youth vaping prevention program for grades 5-12 that has been proven to substantially reduce students' likelihood of vaping, in 5 Crawford County Schools, and the Oblong Children's Home reaching a total of 319 students.
- ◆ CCHD has also partnered with Egyptian Health Department to provide free Narcan to the community.
- ◆ The WIC program provides an abundance of information on nutrition and healthy eating.
- ◆ CCHD was able to bring the Kidney Mobile to Crawford County as a free screening mechanism for kidney diseases.
- ◆ The Department has participated in several Health Fairs to help provide vaccinations and screenings such as blood pressure checks.
- ◆ The Cancer Comfort bag project continues and still provides care packages to cancer patients in Crawford County.
- ◆ CCHD also provides information on health priorities through social media, mobile app, website, newspaper, radio, mailers, billboards and other outreach materials.
- ◆ CCHD staff has been preparing to do the IPLAN process again in 2026.

These are just a few of our services and we hope to add even more services in the new year to continue to be part of the change to make Crawford County even better than it is today. We would like to thank the Crawford County Board, community partners, and the citizens of Crawford County for their continued support of our programs.

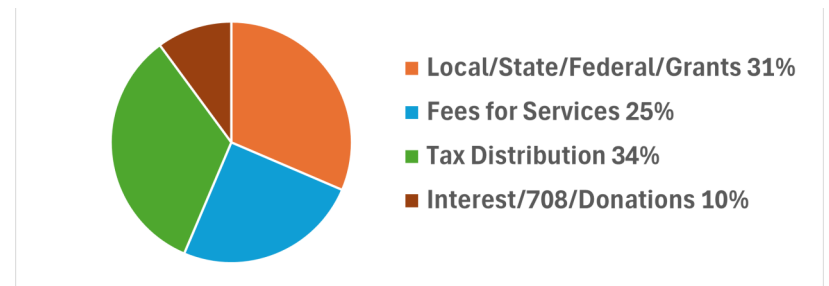
