RE: Additional cases of COVID-19 in Crawford County residents

As of today, there have been a total of thirteen Crawford County residents who have tested positive for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19). Eleven of those residents have recovered. The two confirmed positive today are as follows:

- A male in his 20's
- A male in his 30's

These individuals are recovering at home and the Crawford County Health Department is following up with close contacts of each of individual.

Often persons with COVID-19 do not show symptoms until several days after the virus enters their system. We stress that you take the following precautions:

- Wear a face covering when in public
- Follow social distancing guidelines of 6 feet
- Wash your hands frequently or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol
- Disinfect frequently touched surfaces
- Sneeze or cough into a tissue, throw it away, and wash your hands
- If you are feeling ill, isolate yourself at home and call a medical provider if symptoms worsen.

COVID-19 shares many symptoms with more common respiratory diseases. If you have fever, cough or difficulty breathing, please call your healthcare provider for further guidance.
