RE: Two new positive COVID-19 cases

As of today, there have been a total of twenty-one Crawford County residents who have tested positive for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19). Eighteen of those residents have recovered. The two confirmed positive today are as follows:

- One male less than 10 years of age
- One female in her 30's

These individuals are recovering on home isolation and the Crawford County Health Department is following up with close contacts of each individual.

We encourage residents to take steps to minimize the risk of contracting COVID-19 by wearing a face covering, following social distancing guidelines of 6 feet, washing hands frequently, and disinfecting frequently touched surfaces.

Please be aware of the symptoms of COVID-19, which include fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea. If you are experiencing any of these symptoms, please contact your healthcare provider for further guidance.
