The Crawford County Health Department received notice of a Crawford County resident who tested positive for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19):

- A female in her 50s

The individual is recovering on home isolation. Crawford County Health Department is following up with close contacts of the individual. **If you believe you have been exposed to an active case of COVID-19 it is best to wait 5-7 days to be tested.**

As we see an increase in the number of cases within the community, it is important to monitor yourself for COVID symptoms which include fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea. If you are exhibiting any of these symptoms, please contact your healthcare provider for further guidance.

We strongly urge residents to take steps to minimize the risk of contracting COVID-19 by wearing a face covering, following social distancing guidelines of 6 feet, washing hands frequently, and disinfecting frequently touched surfaces.
