The Crawford County Health Department received notice of a Crawford County resident who tested positive for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19):

- A male in his 40s

The individual is recovering on home isolation. Crawford County Health Department is following up with close contacts of the individual.

If you should be informed by a close contact (who has tested positive for COVID-19) that you have been exposed, please quarantine yourself immediately and notify our office at 618-544-8798. It is our recommendation that testing be performed 5-7 days after exposure to an active case of COVID-19.

We strongly urge residents to take steps to minimize the risk of contracting COVID-19 by wearing a face covering, following social distancing guidelines of 6 feet, washing hands frequently, and disinfecting frequently touched surfaces.

We encourage residents to maintain a personal daily contact diary. Doing so will assist in your recall of close contacts should you be found to be positive in the future and help reduce the spread of COVID-19.

The public is asked to follow and share trusted sources of information on COVID-19. Follow the CDC, IDPH, and CCHD websites and social media accounts for trusted information.
