## Emergency Incident Rehab Group

Organized Group of Medical and Non-Medical, volunteers to provide Rehab to Crawford County Emergency Responders during an Incident.

Volunteers wishing to help provide rehab such as drinks and/or food to emergency responders during an incident must fill out a general contact information sheet, and local background check sheet.

Members will provide updated contact information to the Coordinator. Group will be activated through “911” dispatch or the response agency. Members will be activated via text message or phone call. Group leaders will be established who can assist in activating and organizing members during an incident.

Certified medical volunteers, who provide current copies of certifications to the coordinator, may provide basic vital signs to responder personnel if requested to do so by the responding agency.

Volunteers will be given a Photo ID badge for security clearance, an MRC identifying safety vest, and ball cap to help with identification.

Volunteers will NOT be required to take any training nor ask to perform any other duties as part of CCMRC other than Emergency Rehab. Volunteers will be required to take some general training for activation and safety during an incident.

Volunteers will be covered under Crawford Counties Work Comp insurance when activated and assisting per our group policy/procedure.
